





Wider viewing area

- With patient history at the bottom, there's more room in the main viewing area.
- Click the + to expand a single study, scroll right/left to see more thumbnails, or expand the pane to see up to three rows of thumbnails.
- For even more space, toggle the hiding switch to **Hiding On** in the toolbar to hide thumbnails.






The expanded patient history pane with three rows of thumbnails




Expanded pane with up to three rows of thumbnails


Management and information tools are always visible on the right
