

Test all cats that present with vague signs of disease, anorexia, or nonspecific illness to evaluate for pancreatitis



Investigate

- Consider additional diagnostics
 - Ultrasound
 - Radiographs
 - Quantitative Spec fPL[®] Test (test code FPLI)
- Check for risk factors and concurrent disease
 - Inflammatory bowel disease
 - Hepatitis
 - Hepatic lipidosis
 - Diabetes mellitus

Manage

- Provide supportive therapy
 - Fluids
 - Pain management
 - Antiemetics
- Treat primary disease appropriately, if present

Monitor

- Trend with quantitative Spec fPL Test
- Recheck fPL levels in 2–3 weeks or sooner if clinical signs develop or worsen
